The Editorial Board is a team of committed young writers, videographers and photographers who create context and content for ThreeSixty's online magazine.

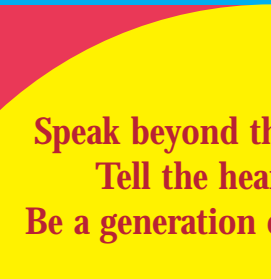
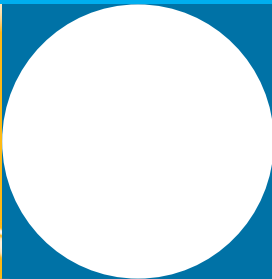

Be a generation of media makers.

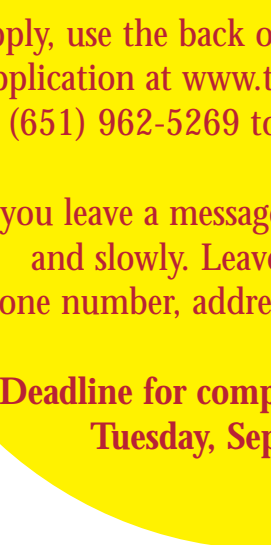

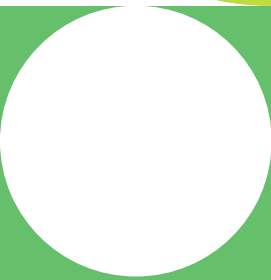

**Staff:** The board is supported by ThreeSixty staff, with periodic training sessions with many of the Twin Cities' top journalists and media makers.

**Eligibility:** We are interested in your enthusiasm and your knowledge. Applicants should be high school students, ages 15-20, with journalism experience in one of the following: writing, photography, videography or podcasting. Joining the Editorial Board requires initiative, commitment, the ability to complete a story on your own time and perseverance during the editing process.

Selection is based on your application, gusto and samples of work. We will interview finalists and then make final selections.
